In the Central Susquehanna River Valley five counties roughly half our elementary children are on free or reduced lunch. **(46.6%. In some schools it's as high as 75 percent*)**. Some children eat only at school and have no food on weekends. In one school district, for example, there are 719 children in 2 elementary schools. 519 of those children are eligible for free and reduced lunch. At the moment over 475 weekend food bags are sent home with children. Dedicated groups of teachers and parents have started (and are starting) backpack programs to feed kids on the weekends. We're raising money to help. A school year is roughly 40 weeks. One local program's costs look like this:

- **\$2 to feed a child for a weekend**
- **\$80 to feed a child for a school year**
- **\$1,000 to feed a class for a school year**

If everyone you know and everyone I know donates generously, The Susquehanna Valley can become the **Valley Where No Child Goes Hungry**. I believe we can do this. Please go to **Love Flows** to donate.
